## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to providing for endorsements for public high school

- 3 students enrolled in special education programs.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.025, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (c-7) and (c-8) to read as follows:
- 7 (c-7) Subject to Subsection (c-8), a student who is enrolled
- 8 in a special education program under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, may
- 9 earn an endorsement on the student's transcript by:
- 10 (1) successfully completing, with or without
- 11 modification of the curriculum, the curriculum requirements
- 12 <u>identified by the State Board of Education under Subsection (a) for</u>
- 13 the foundation high school program; and
- 14 (2) successfully completing, without modification of
- 15 the curriculum, all additional curriculum requirements for that
- 16 endorsement required under Subsections (c-2)(1)(A)(ii),
- 17 (1)(B)(ii), and (1)(C) and developed by the State Board of
- 18 Education under Subsection (c-2)(2).
- 19 <u>(c-8)</u> For purposes of Subsection (c-7), the admission,
- 20 review, and dismissal committee of a student in a special education
- 21 program under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, shall determine whether the
- 22 student is required to achieve satisfactory performance on an
- 23 end-of-course assessment instrument to earn an endorsement on the
- 24 student's transcript.

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 2 school year.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
