A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to placing the name of a deceased or ineligible candidate
3 for public office on the ballot.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 145.039, Election Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 145.039. DECEASED OR INELIGIBLE CANDIDATE'S NAME TO
8 APPEAR ON GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT. (a) If a candidate dies or is
9 declared ineligible after the 74th day before election day, the
10 candidate's name shall be placed on the ballot.

11 (b) The secretary of state by rule may establish a procedure
12 for issuing a certified notice to voters, to be included in the
13 balloting materials for early voting by mail and given to each voter
14 at each polling place during the early voting period and on election
15 day, that a candidate whose name is printed on the ballot has died
16 or been declared ineligible.

17 SECTION 2. Section 145.065, Election Code, is amended to
18 read as follows:

19 Sec. 145.065. DECEASED OR INELIGIBLE CANDIDATE'S NAME TO
20 APPEAR ON GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT. (a) If a candidate dies or is
21 declared ineligible after the 74th day before election day, the
22 candidate's name shall be placed on the ballot.

23 (b) The secretary of state by rule may establish a procedure
24 for issuing a certified notice to voters, to be included in the

1 balloting materials for early voting by mail and given to each voter
2 at each polling place during the early voting period and on election
3 day, that a candidate whose name is printed on the ballot has died
4 or been declared ineligible.

5 SECTION 3. Section 145.096, Election Code, is amended by
6 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

7 (c) The secretary of state by rule may establish a procedure
8 for issuing a certified notice to voters, to be included in the
9 balloting materials for early voting by mail and given to each voter
10 at each polling place during the early voting period and on election
11 day, that a candidate whose name is printed on the ballot has died
12 or been declared ineligible.

13 SECTION 4. Section 172.058, Election Code, is amended by
14 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

15 (d) The secretary of state by rule may establish a procedure
16 for issuing a certified notice to voters, to be included in the
17 balloting materials for early voting by mail and given to each voter
18 at each polling place during the early voting period and on election
19 day, that a candidate whose name is printed on the ballot has died
20 or been declared ineligible.

21 SECTION 5. Section 172.060, Election Code, is amended by
22 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

23 (c) The secretary of state by rule may establish a procedure
24 for issuing a certified notice to voters, to be included in the
25 balloting materials for early voting by mail and given to each voter
26 at each polling place during the early voting period and on election
27 day, that a candidate whose name is printed on the ballot has died

1 or been declared ineligible.

2 SECTION 6. Section 232.045, Election Code, is amended by
3 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

4 (c) The secretary of state by rule may establish a procedure
5 for issuing a certified notice to voters, to be included in the
6 balloting materials for early voting by mail and given to each voter
7 at each polling place during the early voting period and on election
8 day, that a candidate whose name is printed on the ballot has died
9 or been declared ineligible.

10 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
