1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of a portion of U.S. Highway 380 in
 1-20 Young and Jack Counties as the Henry H. King Memorial Highway.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-23 is amended by adding Section 225.123 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 225.123. HENRY H. KING MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The
 1-25 portion of U.S. Highway 380 from the municipal limits of Graham in
 1-26 Young County east to the municipal limits of Bryson in Jack County
 1-27 is designated as the Henry H. King Memorial Highway.

1-28 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-29 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-30 designation as the Henry H. King Memorial Highway and any other
 1-31 appropriate information; and

1-32 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
 1-33 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
