A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to a grant program for reducing workplace violence against
- 3 nurses.

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- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 105, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 105.011 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 105.011. WORKPLACE VIOLENCE PREVENTION GRANT PROGRAM.
- 8 (a) To the extent funding is available, the nursing resource
- 9 section established under Section 105.002 shall administer a grant
- 10 program to fund innovative approaches for reducing verbal and
- 11 physical violence against nurses in hospitals, freestanding
- 12 emergency medical care facilities, nursing facilities, and home
- 13 health agencies.
- 14 (b) The nursing resource section shall require a grant
- 15 recipient to submit periodic reports describing the outcome of the
- 16 activities funded through the grant, including any change in the
- 17 severity and frequency of verbal and physical violence against
- 18 <u>nurses.</u>
- 19 <u>(c) The nursing advisory committee established by Section</u>
- 20 104.0155 shall serve in an advisory capacity for the grant program.
- 21 (d) The department shall provide administrative assistance
- 22 to the nursing resource section in administering the grant program
- 23 under this section.
- (e) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules to

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- 1 implement the grant program, including rules governing the
- 2 submission and approval of grant requests and establishing a
- 3 reporting procedure for grant recipients.
- 4 (f) The nursing resource section may use money transferred
- 5 to the department from the Texas Board of Nursing under Section
- 6 301.155, Occupations Code, to fund the grants authorized by this
- 7 section.
- 8 (g) At least annually, the nursing resource section shall
- 9 publish a report describing the grants awarded under this section,
- 10 including the amount of the grant, the purpose of the grant, and the
- 11 reported outcome of the approach adopted by the grant recipient.
- 12 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 13 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 14 Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to implement
- 15 Section 105.011, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
