5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 322, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 322.0515 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 322.0515. AUTHORIZATION FOR USE OF WHEELCHAIR
8	SELF-RELEASE SEAT BELT; EXCEPTION. (a) Except as provided by
9	Subsection (b) and notwithstanding Section 322.051, a facility
10	shall allow a resident to use a wheelchair self-release seat belt
11	while the resident is in the resident's wheelchair if:
12	(1) the resident demonstrates the ability to release
13	and fasten the seat belt without assistance;
14	(2) the use of the wheelchair self-release seat belt
15	complies with the resident's plan of care; and
16	(3) the facility receives written authorization
17	signed by the resident or the resident's legal guardian for the
18	resident to use the wheelchair self-release seat belt.
19	(b) A facility that advertises as a restraint-free facility
20	is not required to comply with Subsection (a) if the facility:
21	(1) provides to current and prospective residents a
22	written disclosure stating the facility is restraint-free and is
23	not required to comply with a request under Subsection (a); and
24	(2) makes all reasonable efforts to accommodate the

- 3 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 4 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 5 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 6 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 7 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 8 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 9 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 10 of this Act but not later than January 1, 2018, the executive
- 11 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 12 adopt rules necessary to implement this Act.
- 13 SECTION 4. Section 322.0515, Health and Safety Code, as
- 14 added by this Act, applies only to the use of a wheelchair
- 15 self-release seat belt occurring on or after January 1, 2018. Use
- 16 of a wheelchair self-release seat belt occurring before that date
- 17 is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective
- 18 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 19 purpose.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
