## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to authorization for certain health care facilities to
3	secure residents with wheelchair self-release seat belts.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 322, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 322.0515 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 322.0515. AUTHORIZATION FOR WHEELCHAIR SELF-RELEASE
8	SEAT BELT USE. (a) Notwithstanding Section 322.051 and after
9	receipt by a facility of a written authorization signed by a
10	resident or the resident's legal guardian for the resident to use a
11	wheelchair self-release seat belt, the facility shall allow the
12	resident to use a wheelchair self-release seat belt while the
13	resident is in the resident's wheelchair, subject to Subsection
14	<u>(b).</u>
15	(b) A facility may not authorize the use of a wheelchair
16	self-release seat belt under Subsection (a) unless:
17	(1) the resident demonstrates the ability to
18	self-release and fasten the seat belt without assistance; and
19	(2) the use of the wheelchair self-release seat belt
20	complies with the resident's plan of care.
21	SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
22	a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
23	federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
24	the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or

- 1 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 2 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 3 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 4 of this Act but not later than January 1, 2018, the executive
- 5 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 6 adopt rules necessary to implement this Act.
- 7 SECTION 4. Section 322.0515, Health and Safety Code, as
- 8 added by this Act, applies only to the use of a wheelchair
- 9 self-release seat belt occurring on or after January 1, 2018. Use of
- 10 a wheelchair self-release seat belt occurring before that date is
- 11 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 12 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
