A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the early voting period.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Sections 85.001(a) and (e), Election Code, are 5 amended to read as follows:

6 (a) The period for early voting by personal appearance 7 begins on the <u>10th</u> [17th] day before election day and continues 8 through the <u>second</u> [fourth] day before election day, except as 9 otherwise provided by this section.

10 (e) For an election held on the uniform election date in May 11 and any resulting runoff election, the period for early voting by 12 personal appearance begins on the <u>seventh</u> [12th] day before 13 election day and continues through the <u>second</u> [fourth] day before 14 election day.

15 SECTION 2. Sections 85.005(c) and (d), Election Code, are 16 amended to read as follows:

(c) In a county with a population of 100,000 or more, the 17 voting in a primary election or the general election for state and 18 county officers shall be conducted at the main early voting polling 19 place for at least 12 hours on each weekday [of the last week] of the 20 21 early voting period, and the voting in a special election ordered by the governor shall be conducted at the main early voting polling 22 23 place for at least 12 hours on each of the last two days of the early voting period. Voting shall be conducted in accordance with this 24

subsection in those elections in a county with a population under 100,000 on receipt by the early voting clerk of a written request for the extended hours submitted by at least 15 registered voters of the county. The request must be submitted in time to enable compliance with Section 85.067.

6 (d) In an election ordered by a city, early voting by
7 personal appearance at the main early voting polling place shall be
8 conducted for at least 12 hours[+

9 [(1)] on one weekday[, if the early voting period 10 consists of less than six weekdays; or

11 [(2) on two weekdays, if the early voting period 12 consists of six or more weekdays].

13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
