- registration program to prevent transnational motor vehicle theft; 3

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 411.0094 to read as follows:
- Sec. 411.0094. MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION PROGRAM: 8
- TRANSNATIONAL THEFT. (a) In this section, "owner" means the owner 9
- of a motor vehicle as shown on the vehicle registration records of 10
- the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles or the analogous department 11
- or agency of another state or country. 12
- (b) The department shall develop a statewide motor vehicle 13
- 14 registration program to help prevent the transnational theft of
- motor vehicles. The department may not implement the program 15
- 16 unless the legislature subsequently provides by general law for the
- implementation of the program. 17
- 18 (c) Under the program, an owner of a motor vehicle may
- 19 register the motor vehicle with the department to authorize a peace
- officer to stop the registered vehicle before the vehicle crosses 20
- the international border of this state. 21
- (d) The department shall develop a form to register a motor 22
- 23 vehicle under the program. The form must advise the owner of the
- motor vehicle regarding the provisions of Subsection (g). A motor 24

- 1 vehicle may not be registered under the program unless the owner
- 2 consents to the provisions of Subsection (g).
- 3 (e) The program must provide a method for an owner to
- 4 withdraw a motor vehicle from the program. The program may not
- 5 require an owner of a motor vehicle to participate in the program.
- 6 (f) After implementation of the program, the department
- 7 shall maintain a database of all motor vehicles registered under
- 8 the program.
- 9 (g) A peace officer who observes a motor vehicle that is
- 10 registered under the program and is crossing the international
- 11 border of this state may stop the motor vehicle to determine whether
- 12 the motor vehicle is being operated by the owner or with the owner's
- 13 permission.
- 14 (h) The department shall propose rules to administer the
- 15 program and may propose a registration fee in an amount sufficient
- 16 to recover the cost of administering the program.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
