A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to breast-feeding policies of state agency worksites.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 165.003, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 6 (c) The department shall annually submit a list of state
- 7 agencies that are included on the list of "mother-friendly"
- 8 <u>businesses</u> maintained under <u>Subsection</u> (b) to the standing
- 9 committees of the house and senate with jurisdiction over the
- 10 department.
- 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 165, Health and Safety
- 12 Code, is amended by adding Section 165.0035 to read as follows:
- Sec. 165.0035. STATE AGENCY "MOTHER-FRIENDLY" WORKSITE.
- 14 (a) In this section, "state agency" means a board, commission,
- 15 office, department, or other agency in the executive, judicial, or
- 16 <u>legislative branch of state government</u>, including an institution of
- 17 higher education as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code.
- 18 (b) To the extent reasonably practicable, each state agency
- 19 shall develop a policy supporting the practice of worksite
- 20 breast-feeding under Section 165.003 and submit its policy to the
- 21 department.
- (c) The department shall include each state agency that
- 23 develops a policy under this section on the list of
- 24 "mother-friendly" businesses under Section 165.003.

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- 1 SECTION 3. A state agency shall comply with Section
- 2 165.0035, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, not later
- 3 than September 1, 2019.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
