7	amended by adding Section 29.0011 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 29.0011. PROHIBITED PERFORMANCE INDICATOR. (a)
9	Notwithstanding Section 29.001(5), Section 29.010, or any other
10	provision of this code, the commissioner or agency may not adopt or
11	implement a performance indicator in any agency monitoring system,
12	including the performance-based monitoring analysis system, that
13	evaluates the total number of enrolled students or the overall
14	percentage of the total number of enrolled students of a school
15	district or open-enrollment charter school who receive special
16	education services.
17	(b) Subsection (a) does not:
18	(1) prohibit a performance indicator designed to
19	monitor disproportionality by assessing the percentage of specific
20	racial or ethnic groups who receive special education services; or
21	(2) affect the duty of the commissioner or agency to
22	provide and report information as required by state or federal law
