1 AN ACT 2 relating to the issuance of certain specialty license plates, specially marked driver's licenses, and specially marked personal 3 identification certificates. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 504.302, Transportation Code, is amended 6 7 by adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection (b) to read as follows: 8 9 (a-1) The surviving spouse of a person who would be eligible for a specialty license plate under Section 504.308, 504.310, 10 504.315, 504.316, or 504.319 is entitled to register one vehicle 11 12 under the applicable section as long as the spouse remains 13 unmarried. 14 (b) An applicant [for registration] under this section must submit proof of the eligibility of the applicant's deceased spouse 15 16 for the applicable specialty license plate. SECTION 2. Section 504.308, Transportation Code, is amended 17 to read as follows: 18 Sec. 504.308. DISTINGUISHED FLYING CROSS MEDAL RECIPIENTS. 19 The department shall issue specialty license plates for 20 [(a)] persons who have received the Distinguished Flying Cross medal and 21 Distinguished Flying Cross medal with Valor. The license plates 22

23 must bear a depiction of the Distinguished Flying Cross medal and 24 the words "Distinguished Flying Cross" at the bottom of each

1	license plate. License plates issued under this section to
2	recipients of the Distinguished Flying Cross medal with Valor that
3	are not personalized must also include the letter "V" as a prefix or
4	suffix to the numerals on each plate.
5	SECTION 3. Section 504.317, Transportation Code, is amended
6	by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
7	(b-1) A person is eligible to receive specialty license
8	plates under this section if the person is the surviving spouse of a
9	person who had been entitled to specialty plates for veterans with
10	disabilities under Section 504.202, regardless of whether the
11	deceased spouse was issued plates under that section.
12	SECTION 4. Section 521.011, Transportation Code, is amended
13	to read as follows:
14	Sec. 521.011. SERVICES INFORMATION FOR VETERANS. The
15	department and the Texas Veterans Commission shall jointly develop
16	a one-page informational paper about veterans services provided by
17	<u>this state</u> for veterans who receive <u>:</u>
18	(1) a driver's license with a designation under
19	<u>Section 521.1235;</u> or
20	(2) a personal identification certificate with a
21	[veteran's] designation <u>under Section 521.102</u> [a one-page
22	informational paper about veterans services provided by this
23	<pre>state].</pre>
24	SECTION 5. Section 521.101(1), Transportation Code, is
25	amended to read as follows:
26	(l) The application for the personal identification
27	certificate must provide space for the applicant:

(2) "Disabled veteran" and $[\tau]$ "veteran" have the 13 14 meanings assigned by Section 521.1235 [means a person who: 15 [(1) has served in: [(A) the army, navy, air force, coast guard, 16 17 marine corps of the United States; or [(B) the Texas National Guard as defined by 18 Section 431.001, Government Code; and 19 [(2) has been honorably discharged from the branch of 20 21 the service in which the person served]. (b-1) If a disabled veteran provides proof sufficient to the 22 department, the department, on request of the disabled veteran, 23 24 shall include on a personal identification certificate issued to the disabled veteran in any available space on the face of the 25 personal identification certificate or on the reverse side of the 26 personal identification certificate: 27

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(2) the branch of the service in which the disabled

3 veteran served.

4 (c) The department shall provide to the recipient of a
5 personal identification certificate with a [veteran's] designation
6 <u>under this section</u> the informational paper described by Section
7 521.011 at the time the certificate is issued.

(1) a disabled veteran designation; and

8 (d) Notwithstanding any other law and except as provided by 9 <u>Subsection (e), for purposes of obtaining a service or benefit</u> 10 <u>available for disabled veterans in this state, a disabled veteran</u> 11 <u>may use a personal identification certificate described by</u> 12 <u>Subsection (b-1) as satisfactory proof:</u>

(1) that the disabled veteran has a disability rating
described by Section 521.1235(a)(2)(A) or (B), as applicable; and
(2) of branch of service and honorable discharge.

16 (e) A personal identification certificate described by 17 Subsection (b-1) is not satisfactory proof of the disabled 18 veteran's disability rating for purposes of obtaining a property 19 tax exemption provided by Chapter 11, Tax Code.

20 (f) A disabled veteran who renews a personal identification 21 certificate described by Subsection (b-1) shall provide proof 22 sufficient to the department of the disabled veteran's disability 23 rating.

SECTION 7. Section 521.1235, Transportation Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsections (b-1), (d), (e), and (f) to read as follows:

27 (a) In this section:

25	(c) The department shall provide to the recipient of a
26	driver's license with a [veteran's] designation <u>under this section</u>
27	the informational paper described by Section 521.011 at the time

1 the license is issued. 2 (d) Notwithstanding any other law and except as provided by Subsection (e), for purposes of obtaining a service or benefit 3 available for disabled veterans in this state, a disabled veteran 4 5 may use a driver's license described by Subsection (b-1) as satisfactory proof: 6 7 (1) that the disabled veteran has a disability rating described by Subsection (a)(2)(A) or (B), as applicable; and 8 (2) of branch of service and honorable discharge. 9 (e) A driver's license described by Subsection (b-1) is not 10 satisfactory proof of the disabled veteran's disability rating for 11 12 purposes of obtaining a property tax exemption provided by Chapter 11, T<u>ax Code.</u> 13 14 (f) A disabled veteran who renews a driver's license 15 described by Subsection (b-1) shall provide proof sufficient to the department of the disabled veteran's disability rating. 16 17 SECTION 8. Section 521.142(i), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 18 The application must provide space for the applicant: 19 (i) (1) to voluntarily list any <u>information</u> [military 20 service] that may qualify the applicant to receive a license with a 21 [veteran's] designation under Section 521.1235; and 22 (2) to include proof required by the department to 23 24 determine the applicant's eligibility to receive that designation. SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017. 25
