- 7 this Act, as applicable, as soon as practicable following the
- 8 effective date of this Act but not later than January 1, 2018.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
