	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to school district ad valorem tax rates.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 26.08, Tax Code, is amended by adding
5	Subsections (q) and (r) to read as follows:
6	(q) This subsection applies only to a school district
7	described by Subsection (n) whose adopted tax rate was approved at
8	an election under this section in the 2006 tax year or any
9	subsequent tax year. Notwithstanding Subsection (n), for purposes
10	of this section, the rollback tax rate of the school district is the
11	higher of:
12	(1) the amount computed under Subsection (n); or
13	(2) the sum of the following:
14	(A) the highest maintenance and operations tax
15	rate adopted by the district for the 2007 tax year or any subsequent
16	tax year in which the adopted tax rate of the district was approved
17	at an election under this section; and
18	(B) the district's current debt rate.
19	(r) Subsection (q) applies to a school district only if the
20	district has adopted a tax rate equal to or higher than the rate
21	provided by that subsection for any tax year in the preceding 10 tax
22	years.
23	SECTION 2. (a) The comptroller of public accounts shall
24	conduct a study to determine:

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1 (1) the number of school districts that adopt an ad 2 valorem tax rate for the tax year in which this Act takes effect 3 that is lower than the district's ad valorem tax rate for the tax 4 year preceding that tax year and then, for the tax year following 5 the tax year in which this Act takes effect, adopt an ad valorem tax 6 rate that is higher than the district's ad valorem tax rate for the 7 tax year in which this Act takes effect; and

8 (2) the number of school districts that adopted an ad valorem tax rate for the second tax year preceding the tax year in 9 which this Act takes effect that was lower than the district's ad 10 valorem tax rate for the tax year preceding that tax year and then, 11 12 for the tax year preceding the tax year in which this Act takes effect, adopted an ad valorem tax rate that was higher than the 13 14 district's ad valorem tax rate for the second tax year preceding the 15 tax year in which this Act takes effect.

16 (b) The comptroller of public accounts shall report the 17 results of the study conducted under this section to each member of 18 the legislature not later than December 1, 2019.

19 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies to 20 the ad valorem tax rate of a school district beginning with the 2017 21 tax year, except as provided by Subsection (b) of this section.

(b) If the governing body of a school district adopted an ad valorem tax rate for the school district for the 2017 tax year before the effective date of this Act, the change in law made by this Act applies to the ad valorem tax rate of that school district beginning with the 2018 tax year, and the law in effect when the tax rate was adopted applies to the 2017 tax year with respect to that

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1 school district.

2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
