2	relating to outcomes-based funding for general academic teaching
3	institutions.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 62, Education Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER D. OUTCOMES-BASED FUNDING FOR GENERAL ACADEMIC TEACHING
8	INSTITUTIONS [PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE FUNDING]
9	Sec. 62.071. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
10	(1) "At-risk student" means an undergraduate student
11	of an eligible institution:
12	(A) whose score on the Scholastic Assessment Test
13	(SAT) or the American College Test (ACT) is less than the national
14	mean score of students' scores on that test;
15	(B) who has been awarded a grant under the
16	federal Pell Grant program;
17	(C) who was 20 years of age or older on the date
18	the student initially enrolled in the institution;
19	(D) who is enrolled as a part-time student; or
20	(E) who did not receive a high school diploma but
21	received a high school equivalency certificate [within the last six
22	years].
23	(2) ["Critical field" means:
24	[(A) the field of engineering, computer science,

- 1 mathematics, physical science, allied health, nursing, or teacher
- 2 certification in a field of science or mathematics; and
- 3 [(B) any other field of study identified as a
- 4 critical field by the coordinating board in "Closing the Gaps," the
- 5 state's master plan for higher education.
- 6 [(3) "Eligible institution" means a general academic
- 7 teaching institution other than a public state college.
- 8 $\left[\frac{(4)}{1}\right]$ "General academic teaching institution" <u>has</u>
- 9 [and "public state college" have] the meaning [meanings] assigned
- 10 by Section 61.003.
- 11 Sec. 62.072. BIENNIAL DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS TO GENERAL
- 12 ACADEMIC TEACHING INSTITUTIONS BASED ON OUTCOMES METRICS POINTS.
- 13 Except as provided by Section 62.073, for each state fiscal
- 14 biennium, the coordinating board shall distribute any funds
- 15 appropriated to the coordinating board by the legislature for the
- 16 purposes of this subchapter, and any other funds made available for
- 17 the purposes of this subchapter, to general academic teaching
- 18 institutions in an amount based on each institution's average
- 19 number of baccalaureate degrees awarded in a year during the
- 20 preceding three years according to the following distribution:
- 21 (1) \$500 for each baccalaureate degree awarded to a
- 22 student who is not an at-risk student; and
- 23 (2) \$1,000 for each baccalaureate degree awarded to an
- 24 at-risk student.
- 25 [FUNDING. (a) For each state fiscal year, the coordinating
- 26 board shall distribute any performance incentive funds
- 27 appropriated by the legislature for purposes of this subchapter,

and any other funds made available for the purposes of this 1 subchapter, to eligible institutions as follows: 2 [(1) 50 percent to be distributed among eligible 3 institutions in proportion to the increase, if any, in the average 4 number of degrees awarded annually by each institution in the two 5 most recent fiscal years from the average number of degrees awarded 6 annually by that institution in the two fiscal years immediately 7 preceding those fiscal years, using the weights assigned to each degree under the table prescribed by Subsection (b); and [(2) the remaining 50 percent to be distributed among 10 eligible institutions in proportion to the average number of 11 degrees awarded annually by each institution in the three most 12 recent fiscal years, using the weights assigned to each degree 13 under the table prescribed by Subsection (b). 14 15 [(b) A number of points is assigned for each degree awarded by an eliqible institution according to the following table: 16 [POINTS 17 [Noncritical Field/Not At-Risk Student 18 [Noncritical Field/At-Risk Student 19 [Critical Field/Not At-Risk Student 20 [Critical Field/At-Risk Student 21 Sec. 62.073. DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS CONTINGENT ON FULL 2.2 FUNDING OF BASE FORMULA FUNDING. Funds may be distributed under 23 this subchapter for a state fiscal biennium only if the instruction 24 and operations formula for all general academic teaching 25 institutions for undergraduate education under Section 61.059 is 26 funded by appropriation for that biennium at a level, per weighted 27

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- 1 semester credit hour, that is equal to or greater than the level at
- 2 which that formula was funded by appropriation for all general
- 3 academic teaching institutions in the preceding state fiscal
- 4 biennium, as that level is adjusted for inflation.
- 5 Sec. 62.074. RULES. The coordinating board shall adopt
- 6 rules for the administration of this subchapter, including any
- 7 rules the coordinating board considers necessary regarding the
- 8 submission to the coordinating board by eligible institutions of
- 9 any student data required for the coordinating board to carry out
- 10 its duties under this subchapter.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
