A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the notice to the parent or other person having lawful control of a public school student concerning the student's class 3 4 performance. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 28.022(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 (a) The board of trustees of each school district shall 8 9 adopt a policy that: 10 (1) provides for a conference between parents and 11 teachers; 12 (2) requires the district, at least once every 12 13 weeks, to give written notice to a parent of: 14 (A) a student's performance in each class or 15 subject; and 16 (B) the number of students that, on the last day of the period for which the notice is given, were enrolled in each 17 of the student's classes, including the class for a particular 18 subject; and 19 requires the district, at least once every three 20 (3) weeks, or during the fourth week of each nine-week grading period, 21 to give written notice to a parent [or legal guardian] of: 22 23 (A) a student's performance in a subject included 24 in the foundation curriculum under Section 28.002(a)(1) if the

1 student's performance in the subject is consistently unsatisfactory, as determined by the district; and 2 3 (B) the number of students that, on the last day 4 of the period for which the notice is given, were enrolled in the student's class for the subject for which the notice is given. 5 6 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 7 school year. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9

10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
