8	Sec. 361.471. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter, "used tire"
9	means a tire that:
10	(1) has been used as a tire on a vehicle; and
11	(2) can still be used for its original intended
12	purpose.
13	Sec. 361.472. COLLECTION OF FEE ON SALE OF TIRE. (a) A
14	seller shall collect a fee in an amount to be determined by the
15	commission on the sale of each new or used tire.
16	(b) On a schedule determined by the commission, a seller
17	shall remit fees collected under Subsection (a) to the comptroller
18	for deposit into an account in the general revenue fund to be used
19	to fund the grant program under Section 361.473.
20	Sec. 361.473. GRANT PROGRAM. The commission shall develop
21	and implement a program to provide grants to local law enforcement
22	agencies to assist those agencies in the enforcement of laws
23	related to the illegal dumping of tires.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
