- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1001.055(a), Education Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The department shall provide to each licensed or exempt
- 8 driver education school and to each parent-taught course provider
- 9 approved under this chapter driver education certificates or
- 10 certificate numbers to enable the school or approved parent-taught
- 11 course provider to print and issue department-approved driver
- 12 education certificates to certify completion of an approved driver
- 13 education course and satisfy the requirements of Sections $\underline{521.1601}$
- 14 and 521.204(a)(2), Transportation Code [$\frac{521.1601}{7}$, Transportation
- 15 Code, as added by Chapter 1253 (H.B. 339), Acts of the 81st
- 16 Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, and 521.1601, Transportation
- 17 Code, as added by Chapter 1413 (S.B. 1317), Acts of the 81st
- 18 Legislature, Regular Session, 2009].
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 521.142(d), Transportation Code, as
- 20 amended by Chapters 1253 (H.B. 339) and 1413 (S.B. 1317), Acts of
- 21 the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, is reenacted to read
- 22 as follows:
- 23 (d) If the applicant is under 25 years of age, the
