A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to regulation by a property owners' association of certain religious displays. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Sections 202.018(a) and (b), Property Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section, a property owners' association may not enforce or adopt a restrictive covenant 8 9 that prohibits a property owner or resident from displaying or affixing on the [entry to the] owner's or resident's property 10 11 [dwelling] one or more religious items the display of which is 12 motivated by the owner's or resident's sincere religious belief. 13 (b) This section does not prohibit the enforcement or 14 adoption of a covenant that, to the extent allowed by the constitution of this state and the United States, prohibits the 15 16 display or affixing of a religious item on the [entry to the] owner's or resident's property [dwelling] that: 17 18 (1) threatens the public health or safety; violates a law other than a law prohibiting the 19 (2) display of r<u>eligious speech; or</u> 20 21 (3) contains language, graphics, or any display that is patently offensive to a passerby for reasons other than its 22 23 religious content [+ [(4) is in a location other than the entry 24

3	[(5) individually or in combination with each other
4	religious item displayed or affixed on the entry door or door frame
5	has a total size of greater than 25 square inches].
6	SECTION 2. Sections 202.018(c) and (d), Property Code, are
7	repealed.
8	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
9	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
10	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
11	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

12 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
