## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the procedure for expunction of arrest records and 3 files for certain persons who are tried for an offense and 4 subsequently acquitted.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 1, Article 55.02, Code of Criminal 7 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1. At the request of the <u>acquitted person</u> [defendant] 8 and after notice to the state, or at the request of the attorney for 9 the state with the consent of the acquitted person, the trial court 10 11 presiding over the case in which the person [defendant] was 12 acquitted, if the trial court is a district court, or a district court in the county in which the trial court is located shall enter 13 14 an order of expunction for a person entitled to expunction under Article 55.01(a)(1)(A) not later than the 30th day after the date of 15 the acquittal. On [Upon] acquittal, the trial court shall advise 16 the acquitted person [defendant] of the right to expunction. The 17 party requesting the order of expunction [defendant] shall provide 18 to the district court all of the information required in a petition 19 for expunction under Section 2(b). The attorney for the acquitted 20 21 person [defendant] in the case in which the person [defendant] was acquitted, if the person [defendant] was represented by counsel, or 22 23 the attorney for the state, if the person [defendant] was not represented by counsel or if the attorney for the state requested 24

1 <u>the order of expunction</u>, shall prepare the order for the court's 2 signature.

3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 4 to the expunction of arrest records and files related to a criminal offense for which the trial of the offense begins on or after the 5 effective date of this Act. The expunction of arrest records and 6 files related to a criminal offense for which the trial of the 7 offense begins before the effective date of this Act is governed by 8 the law in effect on the date the trial begins, and the former law is 9 continued in effect for that purpose. 10

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
