5	SECTION 1. Section 554.002(a), Government Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(a) A state or local governmental entity may not suspend or
8	terminate the employment of, or take other adverse personnel action
9	against, a public employee who in good faith reports a violation of
10	law by the employing governmental entity or another public employee
11	to <u>:</u>
12	(1) the reporting employee's supervisor at the
13	<pre>employing governmental entity;</pre>
14	(2) an individual or office designated by the
15	employing governmental entity as the appropriate individual or
16	office for reporting such grievances;
17	(3) a member of the human resources staff of the
18	<pre>employing governmental entity;</pre>
19	(4) the office of the attorney general; or
20	(5) an appropriate law enforcement authority.
