H.B. No. 617

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the inclusion of American principles in the public school curriculum and instructional materials. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.002, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsection (h-1) to read as follows: 6 7 (h-1) To accomplish the primary purpose stated in Subsection (h), the State Board of Education and each school 8 9 district shall ensure that: (1) the public school curriculum emphasizes: 10 (A) the importance of patriotism, American 11 exceptionalism, United States citizenship, basic democratic 12 values, character development, the moral fabric of American civil 13 society, and an appreciation for the free enterprise system; and 14 (B) an understanding of the principles 15 16 underlying the United States form of government, including the study of the Founding Fathers of the United States, the Declaration 17 of Independence, the United States Constitution, the Bill of 18 19 Rights, and the Federalist Papers; (2) each historical event addressed in the public 20 school curriculum meets a reasonable standard of historical 21 significance, in relation to the limited amount of available 22 23 instructional time; 24 (3) any issue included in the public school curriculum

| 10 | SECTION 2. Section 31.023(a), Education Code, is amended to |

11 read as follows:

For each subject and grade level, the State Board of 12 (a) Education shall adopt a list of instructional materials. The list 13 includes each instructional material submitted for the subject and 14 15 grade level that meets applicable physical specifications adopted by the State Board of Education, that [and] contains material that 16 17 is consistent with the purpose and guidelines of Sections 28.002(h) and (h-1), and that covers [covering] at least half of the elements 18 of the essential knowledge and skills of the subject and grade level 19 in the student version of the instructional material, as well as in 20 21 the teacher version of the instructional material, as determined by 22 the State Board of Education under Section 28.002 and adopted under Section 31.024. 23

24 SECTION 3. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), this 25 Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 school year.

(b) The changes in law made by this Act to Section27 31.023(a), Education Code, apply to instructional materials

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1 adopted by the State Board of Education on or after September 1, 2 2018.

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3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
