5	SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter H, Chapter 1701,
6	Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER H. CONTINUING EDUCATION, REGULAR PSYCHOLOGICAL
8	EXAMINATION, AND YEARLY WEAPONS PROFICIENCY
9	SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, is
10	amended by adding Section 1701.3556 to read as follows:
11	Sec. 1701.3556. REGULAR PSYCHOLOGICAL EXAMINATION. (a)
12	Each peace officer shall submit to the psychological examination
13	described by Section 1701.306 once every 24 months.
14	(b) The commission by rule shall:
15	(1) provide grounds for which a law enforcement agency
16	may exempt a peace officer from the requirements of this section;
17	<u>and</u>
18	(2) adopt procedures to ensure timely and accurate
19	reporting by law enforcement agencies and persons licensed under
20	this chapter of the results of a psychological examination required
21	under this section.
22	(c) The commission shall suspend the license of a peace
23	officer who fails to comply with this section.
