H.B. No. 635

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to issuance of a vendor permit for the sale of goods during
3 an authorized event held in the Texas mall area of the Capitol
4 Complex.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 2165, Government Code, is
7 amended by adding Section 2165.260 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 2165.260. TEXAS MALL AREA VENDOR PERMIT. (a) In this
9 section, the "Texas mall area of the Capitol Complex" means the
10 state-owned property within the area bounded on the north by Martin
11 Luther King, Jr., Boulevard, on the east by Brazos Street, on the
12 south by 15th Street, and on the west by Colorado Street.

13 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the State Preservation
14 Board by rule and in consultation with the commission and other
15 appropriate state agencies shall establish a process for a vendor
16 to apply for and obtain from the board a permit that allows the
17 vendor to sell goods from a rented space during an event authorized
18 by the board and held in the Texas mall area of the Capitol Complex.

19 (c) The State Preservation Board is not required to adopt
20 the rules required under Subsection (b) until the Capitol Complex
21 master plan developed under Section 2166.105 is implemented and the
22 Texas mall proposed in the plan is established.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
