- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 403, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 403.0146 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 403.0146. REPORT ON FISCAL IMPACT OF PENDING SUITS
- 8 AGAINST THE STATE. (a) The comptroller shall produce a report that
- 9 identifies each suit against the state, a state agency, or a state
- 10 official:

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- 11 (1) in which the amount of the monetary claim in
- 12 controversy is \$10 million or more; and
- 13 (2) that is pending as of August 31 of
- 14 each even-numbered fiscal year.
- 15 (b) In preparing the report required under this section, the
- 16 comptroller shall use available information submitted to the
- 17 comptroller by state agencies for the purpose of producing the most
- 18 recent comprehensive annual financial report under Section
- 19 403.013(c). A state agency shall provide any information on
- 20 pending suits requested by the comptroller for the purpose of
- 21 producing the report.
- (c) Information relating to a suit described by Subsection
- 23 (a) provided to the comptroller by a state agency, collected by the
- 24 comptroller from a state agency, or that is used or created by the

- 1 comptroller to produce the report described by this section is
- 2 confidential and not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552.
- 3 (d) Not later than December 31 of each even-numbered year,
- 4 the comptroller shall deliver the report produced under this
- 5 <u>section to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house</u>
- 6 of representatives, House Appropriations Committee, Senate Finance
- 7 Committee, and Legislative Budget Board.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
