1-22 relating to the continuation of the Red River Boundary Commission. 1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 12.057(b), Natural Resources Code, is 1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (b) Not later than July 30, <u>2021</u> [<del>2017</del>], the commission 1-27 shall issue a final report to the governor, lieutenant governor, 1-28 speaker of the house of representatives, and appropriate committees 1-29 of the legislature.

1-30 SECTION 2. Section 12.058, Natural Resources Code, is 1-31 amended to read as follows:

1-32 Sec. 12.058. EXPIRATION OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter 1-33 expires December 31, 2021 [2017].

1-34 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
