4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 402, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 402.040 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 402.040. CRIMINAL JUSTICE WEB PORTAL. (a) The office
8	of the attorney general shall develop and maintain a web portal to
9	collect, compile, and analyze data related to criminal justice in
10	this state. The office shall ensure that the web portal is
11	accessible through the state electronic Internet portal project.
12	(b) The attorney general shall direct each law enforcement
13	agency to submit through the web portal any report required to be
14	submitted by the agency to the office of the attorney general under
15	any law, including information reported under Article 2.139, Code
16	of Criminal Procedure, as added by Chapter 516 (H.B. 1036), Acts of
17	the 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, and Article 2.1395,
18	Code of Criminal Procedure.
19	(c) The web portal must:
20	(1) provide access to reports submitted to the office
21	of the attorney general through the web portal, other than reports
22	that are confidential or protected from disclosure under state or
23	federal law; and
24	(2) include an interactive dashboard that provides an

1	analysis and a visual representation of the data included in the
2	reports described by Subdivision (1).
3	(d) The reports and dashboard required by Subsection (c)
4	must be accessible to the public.
5	(e) In developing the web portal, the office of the attorney
6	general may contract or consult with a nonprofit organization that
7	specializes in web-based data analysis.
8	SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2018, the office of
9	the attorney general shall develop the web portal required under
10	Section 402.040, Government Code, as added by this Act.

11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
