- 2 relating to the establishment of a caseload management system for
- 3 child protective services caseworkers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 40, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 40.0328 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 40.0328. CASEWORKER CASELOAD MANAGEMENT SYSTEM. The
- 8 department shall manage the duties of caseworkers to maintain the
- 9 safety of children in child protective services by establishing a
- 10 <u>caseload management system that:</u>
- 11 (1) assigns a risk score to each child in the
- 12 department's care based on an assessment of the current and
- 13 potential risk of harm to the child from abuse or neglect;
- 14 (2) determines the appropriate number of cases to be
- 15 <u>assigned to a caseworker based on the risk scores of the children</u>
- 16 <u>assigned to the caseworker; and</u>
- 17 (3) proportionally limits the number of children with
- 18 higher risk scores that may be assigned to any one caseworker.
- 19 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 20 of this Act, the Department of Family and Protective Services shall
- 21 establish and implement the caseload management system as required
- 22 under Section 40.0328, Human Resources Code, as added by this Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
