4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 40.0528(d), Human Resources Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(d) <u>The department shall measure the</u> [In reporting
8	information relating to] caseloads of child protective services
9	caseworkers $[au]$ in accordance with standards developed by $[addition]$
10	to reporting caseload by each individual affected by the case,] the
11	department. The standards must include:
12	(1) the total number of children involved in the case;
13	(2) the type of placement for each child involved in
14	the case;
15	(3) the total number of placements for the case;
16	(4) the level of care required for each child involved
17	in the case;
18	(5) the level of department intervention and parental
19	or family services required for the case; and
20	(6) the level of caseworker experience required to
21	appropriately manage the case [shall report the number of cases for
22	each caseworker on the basis of family unit].
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
