On the 8 9 request of the attorney for a parent who is a party in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship filed under this chapter, 10 or the attorney ad litem for the parent's child, the Department of 11 12 Family and Protective Services shall, before the full adversary hearing, provide: 13 14 (1) the name of any person, excluding a department employee, who the department believes is a witness to any of the 15 16 allegations contained in the petition filed by the department; (2) a copy of any arrest record or offense report 17 relating to the parent that is material to the allegations 18 contained in the petition filed by the department; and 19 (3) a copy of any photograph that constitutes or 20 contains evidence that is material to the allegations contained in 21 the petition filed by the department. 22 23 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to a suit affecting the parent-child relationship filed on or after 24
