## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the board of trustees of the Texas County and District
- 3 Retirement System.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 845.001, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 845.001. COMPOSITION OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES. (a) The
- 8 board of trustees is composed of nine members as follows:
- 9 (1) four members who serve on a county commissioners
- 10 court of a participating subdivision;
- 11 (2) one member who serves on the governing body of a
- 12 participating special district;
- 13 (3) one member who is an employee or retiree of a
- 14 participating county; and
- 15 <u>(4) three persons who are representatives of the</u>
- 16 public.
- 17 (b) A member of the board of trustees described by
- 18 Subsection (a)(1), (2), or (3) may not reside in the same county as
- 19 another member.
- SECTION 2. Section 845.003, Government Code, is amended by
- 21 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsections (a-1) and
- 22 (a-2) to read as follows:
- 23 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), to [To] be
- 24 eligible to serve as a trustee a person must be [+

- 1  $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$  a member or retiree of the retirement system
- 2 [and an employee of a participating subdivision; or
- 3 [(2) a retiree of the retirement system].
- 4 (a-1) To be eligible to serve as a trustee who is a
- 5 representative of the public, a person may not:
- 6 (1) be a member or retiree of the retirement system;
- 7 (2) hold or have held an elected office; or
- 8 (3) be or have been an employee of a governmental 9 entity.
- 10 (a-2) A trustee who is a representative of the public may
- 11 not vote on any matter in which the trustee has a pecuniary
- 12 interest. Failure to comply with this subsection is a ground for
- 13 removal from the board of trustees.
- 14 (b) If a person serving as a trustee ceases to meet an
- 15 eligibility requirement under <u>Section 845.001</u> or this <u>section</u>
- 16 [Subsection (a)], the person shall vacate the office of trustee.
- 17 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act to Sections
- 18 845.001 and 845.003, Government Code, regarding the composition of
- 19 and eligibility requirements for the board of trustees of the Texas
- 20 County and District Retirement System, does not affect the
- 21 entitlement of a member serving on the board immediately before the
- 22 effective date of this Act to continue to serve as a member of the
- 23 board for the remainder of the member's term. As the terms of board
- 24 members expire or as a vacancy occurs on the board, the governor
- 25 shall appoint a member to the board as necessary to comply with
- 26 Sections 845.001 and 845.003, Government Code, as amended by this
- 27 Act.
