2	relating to ballot propositions authorizing certain political
3	subdivisions to issue bonds.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 1251, Government Code, is amended by
6	designating Sections 1251.001, 1251.002, 1251.003, 1251.004,
7	1251.005, and 1251.006 as Subchapter A and adding a subchapter
8	heading to read as follows:
9	SUBCHAPTER A. BOND ELECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR COUNTIES AND
10	MUNICIPALITIES
11	SECTION 2. Chapter 1251, Government Code, is amended by
12	adding Subchapter B to read as follows:
13	SUBCHAPTER B. BOND ELECTION BALLOTS FOR CERTAIN POLITICAL
14	SUBDIVISIONS
15	Sec. 1251.051. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
16	(1) "Debt obligation" means an issued public security,
17	as defined by Section 1201.002.
18	(2) "Political subdivision" means a county,
19	municipality, or school district.
20	Sec. 1251.052. CONTENTS OF BALLOT PROPOSITION. (a) The
21	proposition submitted for an election to authorize a political
22	subdivision to issue bonds must distinctly state:
23	(1) as a total amount and as a per capita amount:
24	(A) the then-current combined principal and

- 1 interest required to pay all outstanding debt obligations of the
- 2 political subdivision on time and in full; and
- 3 (B) the estimated combined principal and
- 4 interest required to pay the bonds to be authorized on time and in
- 5 full; and
- 6 (2) if the bonds are supported by property taxes, the
- 7 <u>annual increase in property taxes attributable to the bonds to be</u>
- 8 issued that each homeowner of an average-priced home within the
- 9 political subdivision may be required to pay.
- 10 (b) The requirements for a proposition prescribed by this
- 11 section are in addition to any other requirements prescribed by
- 12 law. To the extent of a conflict between this section and Section
- 13 <u>52.072</u>, Election Code, this section controls.
- Sec. 1251.053. ONLINE SAMPLE BALLOT. A sample of the ballot
- 15 printed for an election to authorize a political subdivision to
- 16 <u>issue bonds must be posted on the political subdivision's Internet</u>
- 17 website, if the political subdivision maintains a website, as soon
- 18 as practicable after the official ballots have been prepared and
- 19 must remain posted until the day following the election.
- Sec. 1251.054. FORM OF BALLOT. The secretary of state shall
- 21 develop a form of the ballot for an election described by this
- 22 <u>subchapter</u>. A political subdivision is not required to use the
- 23 form.
- 24 SECTION 3. (a) Sections 1251.052 and 1251.053, Government
- 25 Code, as added by this Act, apply only to a ballot proposition for a
- 26 bond election ordered on or after January 1, 2018.
- 27 (b) Not later than December 1, 2017, the secretary of state

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- 1 shall make available on the secretary of state's Internet website a
- 2 form of the ballot described by Section 1251.054, Government Code,
- 3 as added by this Act.
- 4 SECTION 4. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 5 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
- 6 (b) Sections 1251.052 and 1251.053, Government Code, as
- 7 added by this Act, take effect January 1, 2018.
