5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 5, Local Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Chapter 179 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 179. VERIFICATION OF EMPLOYEE INFORMATION
9	Sec. 179.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "E-verify program" has the meaning assigned by
11	Section 673.001, Government Code.
12	(2) "Political subdivision" means a county,
13	municipality, school district, junior college district, other
14	special district, or other subdivision of state government.
15	Sec. 179.002. VERIFICATION. A political subdivision shall
16	register and participate in the E-verify program to verify
17	information of all new employees.
18	Sec. 179.003. STATE FUNDING PROHIBITED FOR FAILURE TO
19	PARTICIPATE IN E-VERIFY. Beginning the September 1, 2018, state
20	fiscal year, a political subdivision may not receive state funds if
21	the political subdivision fails to register or participate in the
22	E-verify program as required by Section 179.002. A political
23	subdivision denied state funds under this section may receive state
24	funds beginning the state fiscal year following the state fiscal

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- 1 year in which the political subdivision fully complies with the
- 2 requirements of Section 179.002. The Governor's Office of Budget,
- 3 Planning, and Policy shall adopt rules to implement this section
- 4 uniformly among state agencies from which state funds are
- 5 distributed to a political subdivision.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
