5	SECTION 1. Section 572.032(a-1), Government Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a-1) The commission shall remove the home address of <u>an</u>
8	<u>individual</u> [a judge or justice] from a financial statement filed <u>by</u>
9	the individual under this subchapter before:
10	(1) permitting a member of the public to view the
11	<pre>statement; [or]</pre>
12	(2) providing a copy of the statement to a member of
13	the public <u>; or</u>
14	(3) making the statement available to the public on
15	the commission's Internet website, if the commission makes
16	statements filed under this subchapter available on its website.
17	SECTION 2. Section 572.032(a-1), Government Code, as
18	amended by this Act, applies to a financial statement filed under
19	Subchapter B, Chapter 572, Government Code, regardless of whether
20	the statement was required to be filed before, on, or after the
21	effective date of this Act.
22	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
