- 5 SECTION 1. Section 572.032(a-1), Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) The commission shall remove the home address of \underline{an}
- 8 $\underline{\text{individual}}$ [a judge or justice] from a financial statement filed $\underline{\text{by}}$
- 9 the individual under this subchapter before:
- 10 (1) permitting a member of the public to view the
- 11 statement; [or]
- 12 (2) providing a copy of the statement to a member of
- 13 the public; or
- 14 (3) making the statement available to the public on
- 15 the commission's Internet website, if the commission makes
- 16 statements filed under this subchapter available on its website.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 572.032(a-1), Government Code, as
- 18 amended by this Act, applies to a financial statement filed under
- 19 Subchapter B, Chapter 572, Government Code, regardless of whether
- 20 the statement was required to be filed before, on, or after the
- 21 effective date of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
