AN ACT

relating to allowing certain individuals appointed by the governor 2 to state office to file required financial statements by certified 3 mail. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- SECTION 1. Section 572.0291, Government Code, is amended to 6 7 read as follows:
- Sec. 572.0291. ELECTRONIC FILING REQUIRED. (a) Except as 8 provided by Subsection (b), a [A] financial statement filed with 9 the commission must be filed by computer diskette, modem, or other 10 means of electronic transfer, using computer software provided by 11 12 the commission or computer software that meets commission specifications for a standard file format. 13
- (b) An individual who was appointed to office by the 14 governor before December 31, 2016, and who is required to file a 15 16 financial statement with the commission under this subchapter may file the financial statement by certified mail if the individual 17 does not own a personal computer or does not have access to the 18 Internet at the individual's residence. The filing by mail must be 19 in compliance with Section 572.029. 20
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 2.4
