(a) Except as 7 provided by Subsection (b), a [A] financial statement filed with 8 the commission must be filed by computer diskette, modem, or other 9 means of electronic transfer, using computer software provided by 10 11 the commission or computer software that meets commission 12 specifications for a standard file format. 13 (b) An individual who was appointed to office and who is 14 required to file a financial statement with the commission under this subchapter may file the financial statement by certified mail. 15 16 The filing by mail must be in compliance with Section 572.029.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
