A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to allowing certain individuals appointed by the governor 3 to state office to file required financial statements by certified 4 mail.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 572.0291, Government Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:

8 Sec. 572.0291. ELECTRONIC FILING REQUIRED. (a) Except as 9 provided by Subsection (b), a [A] financial statement filed with 10 the commission must be filed by computer diskette, modem, or other 11 means of electronic transfer, using computer software provided by 12 the commission or computer software that meets commission 13 specifications for a standard file format.

(b) An individual who was appointed to office by the governor before December 31, 2016, and who is required to file a financial statement with the commission under this subchapter may file the financial statement by certified mail if the individual does not own a personal computer or does not have access to the Internet at the individual's residence. The filing by mail must be in compliance with Section 572.029.

21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
