- provided by Subsection (b), a [A] financial statement filed with 9
- the commission must be filed by computer diskette, modem, or other 10
- means of electronic transfer, using computer software provided by 11
- 12 the commission or computer software that meets commission
- specifications for a standard file format. 13
- (b) An individual who was appointed to office by the 14
- governor before December 31, 2016, and who is required to file a 15
- 16 financial statement with the commission under this subchapter may
- file the financial statement by certified mail if the individual 17
- does not own a personal computer or does not have access to the 18
- Internet at the individual's residence. The filing by mail must be 19
- in compliance with Section 572.029. 20
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22
