A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the duty of a property owner to send a lessee of the 3 property who is required to pay the ad valorem taxes on the property 4 a copy of any notice of appraised value received by the property 5 owner.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 41.413, Tax Code, is amended by amending
Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

9 (d) <u>A</u> [The] property owner shall [timely] send to <u>a</u> [the] person leasing [the] property under a contract described by this 10 section a copy of any notice of appraised value of the property [the 11 property's reappraisal] received by the property owner. The 12 property owner must send the notice not later than the 10th day 13 after the date the property owner receives the notice [Failure of 14 the owner to send a copy of the notice to the person leasing the 15 16 property does not affect the time within which the person leasing the property may protest the appraised value]. 17

18 (e) A person authorized by this section to protest before 19 the appraisal review board a determination of the appraised value 20 of property is entitled to file a notice of the protest not later 21 than the 30th day after the date the notice is otherwise required to 22 be filed under this title if the property owner does not comply with 23 the requirements of Subsection (d).

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SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to

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- a notice of appraised value received by a property owner on or after
 the effective date of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
