3	agencies as a veterans liaison.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 657, Government Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 657. VETERAN'S EMPLOYMENT PREFERENCES; VETERANS LIAISON
8	SECTION 2. Chapter 657, Government Code, is amended by
9	adding Section 657.011 to read as follows:
10	Sec. 657.011. VETERANS LIAISON. (a) Each state agency with
11	more than 500 full-time employees, using existing resources and
12	employees, shall designate a full-time employee of the agency to
13	serve as the veterans liaison for the agency. The employee's duties
14	serving as the veterans liaison are secondary to the employee's
15	primary duties for the agency.
16	(b) The veterans liaison shall:
17	(1) stay informed on trends and developments in
18	hiring veterans for positions within the agency and of services
19	available to veterans within and outside the agency;
20	(2) recruit veterans for open positions within the
21	agency; and
22	(3) serve as the contact for veterans within and
23	outside the agency to provide information about the agency and
24	veteran's employment and services available within and outside the

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1 agency.

2 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2017, each state 3 agency with more than 500 full-time employees shall designate a 4 full-time employee of the agency to serve as the veterans liaison 5 for the agency as required by Section 657.011, Government Code, as 6 added by this Act.

7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
