- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.103, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (b), (c), and (d) and adding Subsection (c-1)
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The basic allotment of a school district that contains
- 9 at least 300 square miles and has not more than 1,600 students in
- 10 average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the formula:
- 11 $AA = (1 + ((1,600 ADA) \times .0005 [.0004])) \times ABA$
- 12 (c) The basic allotment of a school district that contains
- 13 <u>at least 150 square miles but</u> less than 300 square miles and has not
- 14 more than 1,600 students in average daily attendance is adjusted by
- 15 applying the formula:
- AA = $(1 + ((1,600 ADA) \times .00035 [.00025])) \times ABA$
- 17 (c-1) The basic allotment of a school district that contains
- 18 less than 150 square miles and has not more than 1,600 students in
- 19 <u>average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the formula:</u>
- $AA = (1 + ((1,600 ADA) \times .0003)) \times ABA$
- 21 (d) The basic allotment of a school district that offers a
- 22 kindergarten through grade 12 program and has less than 5,000
- 23 students in average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the
- 24 formula, of the following formulas, that results in the greatest

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1 adjusted allotment:
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- 2 (1) the formula in Subsection (b) $_{\underline{\prime}}$ [$_{\underline{\bullet r}}$] (c) $_{\underline{\prime}}$ or (c-1)
- 3 for which the district is eligible; or
- 4 (2) $AA = (1 + ((5,000 ADA) \times .000025)) \times ABA.$
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
