H.B. No. 881

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the small and mid-sized district adjustments under the Foundation School Program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 42.103, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsections (b), (c), and (d) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:

(b) The basic allotment of a school district that contains at least 300 square miles and has not more than 1,600 students in average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the formula:

$$AA = (1 + ((1,600 - ADA) \times .0005 [-0.0004])) \times ABA$$

(c) The basic allotment of a school district that contains at least 150 square miles but less than 300 square miles and has not more than 1,600 students in average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the formula:

$$AA = (1 + ((1,600 - ADA) \times .00035 [-0.00025])) \times ABA$$

(c-1) The basic allotment of a school district that contains less than 150 square miles and has not more than 1,600 students in average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the formula:

$$\underline{AA = (1 + ((1,600 - ADA) \times .0003)) \times ABA}$$

(d) The basic allotment of a school district that offers a kindergarten through grade 12 program and has less than 5,000 students in average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the formula, of the following formulas, that results in the greatest

1 adjusted allotment:

2 (1) the formula in Subsection (b), ~~[or]~~ (c), or (c-1)
3 for which the district is eligible; or

4 (2) $AA = (1 + ((5,000 - ADA) \times .000025)) \times ABA$.

5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
