H.B. No. 883

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to funding for career and technology programs in public
3 schools.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 42.154(a), Education Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 (a) For each full-time equivalent student in average daily
8 attendance in an approved career and technology education program
9 in grades nine through 12 or in career and technology education
10 programs for students with disabilities in grades seven through 12,
11 a district is entitled to:

12 (1) an annual allotment equal to the adjusted basic
13 allotment multiplied by a weight of 1.60 [~~1.35~~]; and

14 (2) \$50, if the student is enrolled in:

15 (A) two or more advanced career and technology
16 education classes for a total of three or more credits; or

17 (B) an advanced course as part of a tech-prep
18 program under Subchapter T, Chapter 61.

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
