Section 42.154(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) For each full-time equivalent student in average daily attendance in an approved career and technology education program 8 in grades nine through 12 or in career and technology education 9 programs for students with disabilities in grades seven through 12, 10 a district is entitled to: 11 12 (1) an annual allotment equal to the adjusted basic 13 allotment multiplied by a weight of 1.60 [1.35]; and \$50, if the student is enrolled in: 14 (2) 15 (A) two or more advanced career and technology education classes for a total of three or more credits; or 16 17 (B) an advanced course as part of a tech-prep program under Subchapter T, Chapter 61. 18 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
