- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 88, Education Code, is 6
- 7 amended by adding Section 88.126 to read as follows:

- 2 (4) "Nongovernment member" means a member who is not a
- 3 state employee member, a local government employee member, or an
- 4 employee of The Texas A&M University System.
- 5 (5) "Regional incident management team" means a
- 6 regional incident management team established under Section 88.122
- 7 or under the state emergency management plan under Section 418.042,
- 8 Government Code, and coordinated by the Texas A&M Forest Service to
- 9 assist the state with managing incident response activities before
- 10 and following a natural or man-made disaster.
- 11 (6) "State employee member" means a member employed by
- 12 an agency of the state other than a component of The Texas A&M
- 13 University System.
- 14 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, during any period in
- 15 which an intrastate fire mutual aid system team or a regional
- 16 incident management team is activated by the Texas Division of
- 17 Emergency Management, or during any training session sponsored or
- 18 sanctioned by the Texas Division of Emergency Management for an
- 19 intrastate fire mutual aid system team or a regional incident
- 20 <u>management team</u>, a <u>participating nongovernment member</u> or local
- 21 government employee member is included in the coverage provided
- 22 under Chapter 501, Labor Code, in the same manner as an employee, as
- 23 defined by Section 501.001, Labor Code.
- (c) Service with an intrastate fire mutual aid system team
- 25 or a regional incident management team by a state employee member
- 26 who is activated is considered to be in the course and scope of the
- 27 employee's regular employment with the state.

- 6 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 408.0445, Labor Code, is

- SECTION 3. Section 408.0445, Labor Code, is amended by
- 12 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- (c) For purposes of computing income benefits or death
- 14 benefits under Section 88.126, Education Code, the average weekly
- 15 wage of an intrastate fire mutual aid system team member or a
- 16 regional incident management team member, as defined by Section
- 17 88.126, Education Code, who is engaged in authorized training or
- 18 duty is an amount equal to the sum of the member's regular weekly
- 19 wage at any employment, including self-employment, that the member
- 20 holds in addition to serving as a member of an intrastate fire
- 21 <u>mutual aid system team or a regional incident management team, as</u>
- 22 applicable, except that the amount may not exceed 100 percent of the
- 23 state average weekly wage as determined under Section 408.047. A
- 24 member for whom an average weekly wage cannot be computed shall be
- 25 paid the minimum weekly benefit established by the division.

- 3 (g) For purposes of this chapter and Section 88.126,
- 4 Education Code, the Texas A&M Forest Service shall perform all
- 5 duties of an employer in relation to an intrastate fire mutual aid
- 6 system team member or a regional incident management team member
- 7 who is injured and receives benefits under this chapter.
- 8 SECTION 6. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to a claim for workers' compensation benefits based on a
- 10 compensable injury that occurs on or after the effective date of
- 11 this Act. A claim based on a compensable injury that occurs before
- 12 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
- 13 the date the compensable injury occurred, and the former law is
- 14 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 15 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
