A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the time for returning mail ballots. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 86.007, Election Code, is amended by 4 5 amending Subsections (a), (d), and (g) and adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows: 6 7 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d) $\underline{\text{or}(d-1)}$, a marked ballot voted by mail must arrive at the address on the carrier 8 9 envelope before the time the polls are required to close on election 10 day. A marked ballot voted by mail that arrives after the 11 (d) 12 time prescribed by Subsection (a) shall be counted if: 13 (1) the ballot was cast from an address outside the United States; 14 the carrier envelope was placed for delivery 15 (2) before the time the ballot is required to arrive under Subsection 16 (a); and 17 (3) the ballot arrives at the address on the carrier 18 envelope not later than the eighth [fifth] day after the date of the 19 20 election, except that if that date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or 21 legal state or national holiday, then the deadline is extended to the next regular business day. 22 23 (d-1) A marked ballot voted by mail that arrives after the time prescribed by Subsection (a) shall be counted if: 24

1	(1) balloting materials are sent after the time
2	prescribed by Section 86.004 for providing the ballots; and
3	(2) the ballot arrives at the address on the carrier
4	envelope not later than the eighth day after the date of the
5	election, except that if that date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or
6	legal state or national holiday, then the deadline is extended to
7	the next regular business day.
8	(g) The secretary of state shall prescribe procedures as
9	necessary to implement Subsections [Subsection] (d) and $(d-1)$.
10	SECTION 2. Section 67.003(c), Election Code, is amended to
11	read as follows:
12	(c) In an election described by Section 65.051(a-1) or in an
13	election in which Section 86.007(d-1)(1) applies, the time for the
14	local canvass may be set not later than the 14th day after election
15	day.
16	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
