 1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the designation of a portion of Farm-to-Market Road 518
 1-21 in Pearland as the Officer Endy Ekpanya Memorial Highway.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-24 is amended by adding Section 225.123 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 225.123. OFFICER ENDY EKpanya MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)
 1-26 The portion of Farm-to-Market Road 518 in Pearland between its
 1-27 intersection with State Highway 35 and Sunset Meadows Drive is
 1-28 designated as the Officer Endy Ekpanya Memorial Highway.

1-29 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-30 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-31 designation as the Officer Endy Ekpanya Memorial Highway and any
 1-32 other appropriate information; and

1-33 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
 1-34 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
