A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the registration of voters at a polling place and
- 3 related procedures.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 12, Election Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 12.007 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 12.007. CERTAIN ELECTION OFFICERS ARE VOTER
- 8 REGISTRARS. An election officer serving a polling place for early
- 9 voting by personal appearance is a deputy voter registrar and has
- 10 the same authority as a regular deputy registrar.
- 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 63, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 12 Section 63.010 to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 63.010. REGISTRATION AT POLLING PLACE; VOTING
- 14 PROCEDURES. (a) This section applies to the conduct of voting and
- 15 to the registration of voters notwithstanding and in addition to
- 16 other applicable provisions of this code.
- 17 (b) A person who would be eligible to vote in an election
- 18 under Section 11.001, but for the requirement to be a registered
- 19 voter, shall be accepted for voting in the precinct of the person's
- 20 <u>residence if, on the day the person offers to vote, the person:</u>
- 21 (1) submits a voter registration application that
- 22 complies with Section 13.002;
- 23 (2) presents the proof of identification required by
- 24 Section 63.001 and, if that identification does not establish the

- 1 person's residence, one of the following forms of identification:
- 2 (A) a driver's license, license to carry a
- 3 concealed handgun, or personal identification card issued to the
- 4 person by the Department of Public Safety, regardless of whether
- 5 the license or card has expired;
- 6 (B) official mail addressed to the person by name
- 7 from a governmental entity;
- 8 <u>(C) a copy of a current utility bill, bank</u>
- 9 statement, government check, paycheck, or other government
- 10 document that shows the name and address of the voter; or
- 11 (D) any other form of identification prescribed
- 12 by the secretary of state that establishes the person's residence;
- 13 and
- 14 (3) completes and signs a voter registration
- 15 affidavit, in a form prescribed by the secretary of state, that
- 16 contains the following oath:
- 17 I, _____, HEREBY CERTIFY UNDER PENALTY OF
- PERJURY THAT, TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE, I HAVE NOT,
- 19 NOR WILL I, CAST MORE THAN ONE BALLOT IN THIS ELECTION.
- 20 (c) Persons voting under this section shall be processed
- 21 separately at the polling place from persons who are voting under
- 22 <u>regular procedures.</u>
- 23 <u>(d) The secretary of state shall prescribe the procedures</u>
- 24 necessary to implement this section and to ensure the proper and
- 25 orderly conduct of elections.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
