A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the required vote by a presidential elector; providing
- 3 a civil penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 192.002, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A person who violates Section 192.009(a) is ineligible
- 8 to serve as an elector in all subsequent elections.
- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 192, Election Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Section 192.009 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 192.009. REQUIRED VOTE BY ELECTOR. (a) At the meeting
- 12 of electors, an elector shall vote for the candidates for president
- 13 and vice-president receiving the most votes in the general election
- 14 for state and county officers.
- 15 (b) An elector who violates Subsection (a) is liable to this
- 16 state for a civil penalty of \$5,000.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
