A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to coverage for certain breast cancer screening procedures
- 3 under certain health benefit plans.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 1356, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 1356. [LOW-DOSE] MAMMOGRAPHY
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1356.001, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 1356.001. DEFINITIONS [DEFINITION]. In this chapter:
- 11 (1) "Breast tomosynthesis" means a radiologic
- 12 procedure that involves the acquisition of projection images over a
- 13 stationary breast to produce cross-sectional digital
- 14 three-dimensional images of the breast.
- 15 (2) "Low-dose[, "low-dose] mammography" means the
- 16 x-ray examination of the breast using equipment dedicated
- 17 specifically for mammography, including an x-ray tube, filter,
- 18 compression device, and screens, [films, and cassettes,] with an
- 19 average radiation exposure delivery of less than one rad
- 20 mid-breast, with two views for each breast, digital mammography, or
- 21 breast tomosynthesis.
- SECTION 3. Section 1356.005(a), Insurance Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- 24 (a) A health benefit plan that provides coverage to a female

- 1 who is 35 years of age or older must include coverage for an annual
- 2 screening by <u>all forms of</u> low-dose mammography for the presence of
- 3 occult breast cancer.
- 4 SECTION 4. Sections 1356.001 and 1356.005, Insurance Code,
- 5 as amended by this Act, apply only to a health benefit plan that is
- 6 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1,
- 7 2018. A plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before
- 8 January 1, 2018, is governed by the law as it existed immediately
- 9 before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in
- 10 effect for that purpose.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
